5.2277 To enact section ~~5.2269~~ of the Revised Code to designate the ninth day of July as "Traumatic Brain Injury Awareness Day."

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

5.2277 SECTION 1. That section ~~5.2269~~ of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

5.2277 Sec. ~~5.2269~~ The ninth day of July is designated as "Traumatic Brain Injury Awareness Day" to increase public awareness of traumatic brain injuries.

5.2277 SECTION 2. In enacting section ~~5.2269~~ of the Revised Code, the General Assembly joins with BrainSong and the Brain Injury Association of Ohio in recognizing the importance of efforts to increase public awareness of traumatic brain injuries.

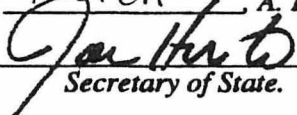

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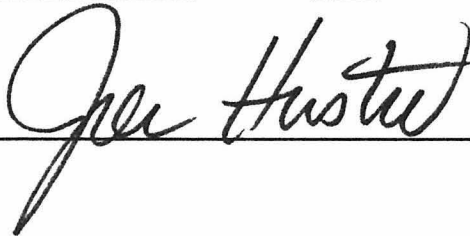
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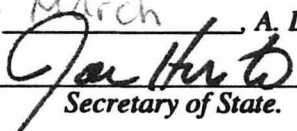
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
