as follows:

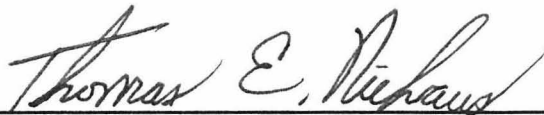
Sec. 5.2275. The month of May is designated as "Pediatric Stroke

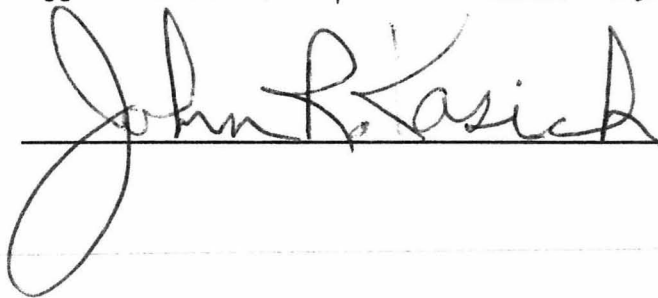

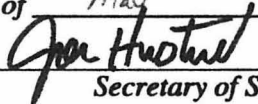
