To enact section 5.25 of the Revised Code to designate the first week of July as "Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome Awareness Week."


*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:*

SECTION 1. That section 5.25 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.25. The first week of July is designated as "Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome Awareness Week" to increase public awareness of neonatal abstinence syndrome as a health concern.
