To amend section 5.2240 of the Revised Code to designate the first week of December as "Crohn's and Colitis Awareness Week."

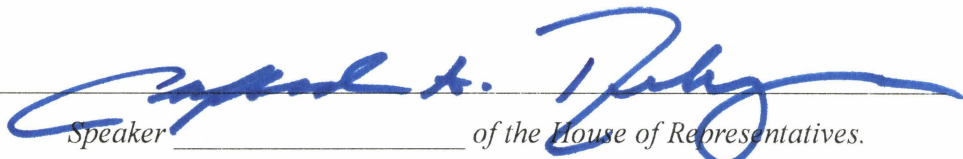
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

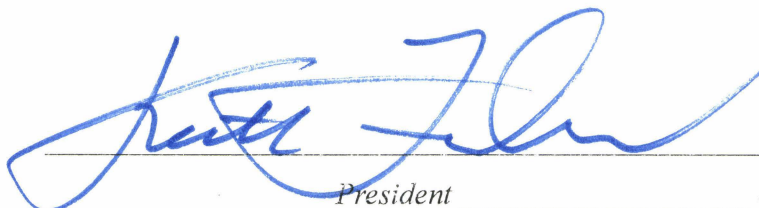
SECTION 1. That section 5.2240 of the Revised Code be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 5.2240. The twenty-third day of May is designated as "Crohn's and Colitis Awareness Day."

The first week of December is designated as "Crohn's and Colitis Awareness Week."

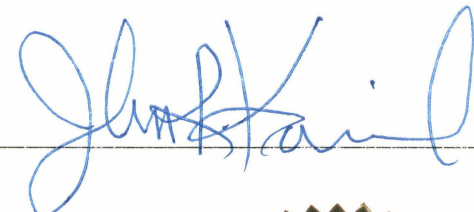
SECTION 2. That existing section 5.2240 of the Revised Code is hereby repealed.

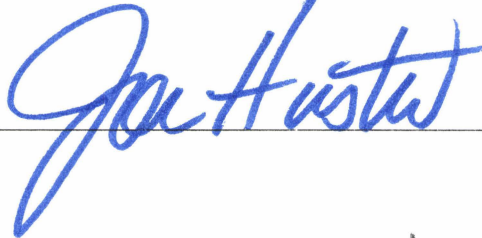

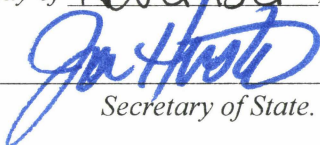
