

AN ACT

To make supplemental appropriations related to transportation for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. All items in this section are hereby appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2016 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2017. The appropriations made in this act are in addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2016-FY 2017 biennium.

SECTION 2. Within the limits set forth in this act, the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for as though made in the transportation budget act of the 131st General Assembly.

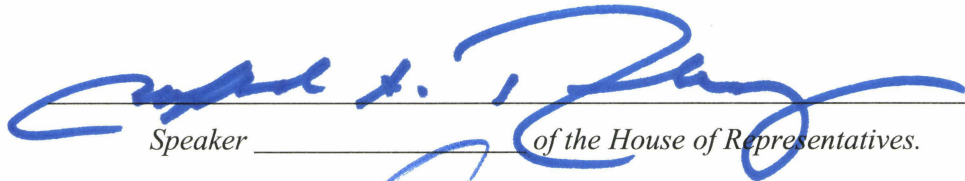
The appropriations made in this act are subject to all provisions of the transportation budget act of the 131st General Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations.

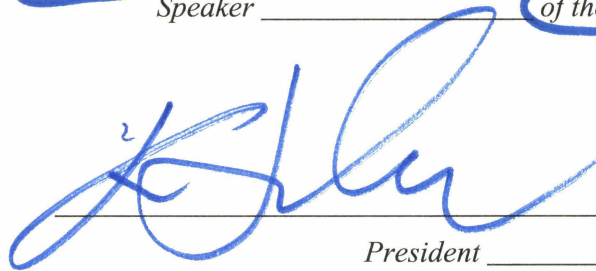
SECTION 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure

necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to authorize increased spending for transportation purposes as a result of increased anticipated revenue. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.

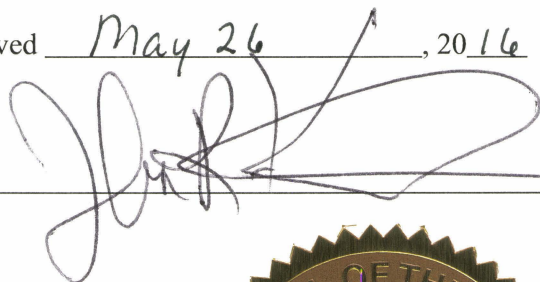

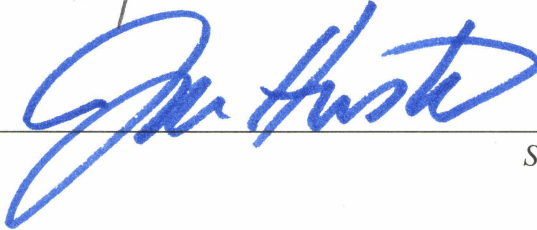

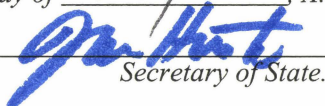
