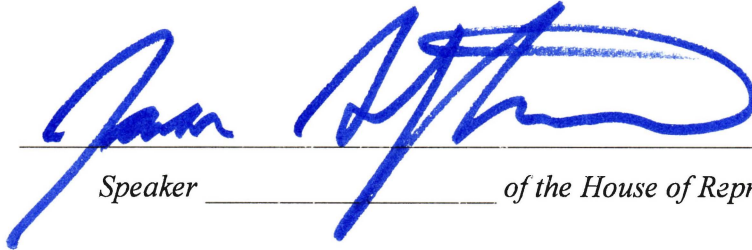
AN ACT

To enact section 5.2316 of the Revised Code to designate November 19th as "James A. Garfield Day."

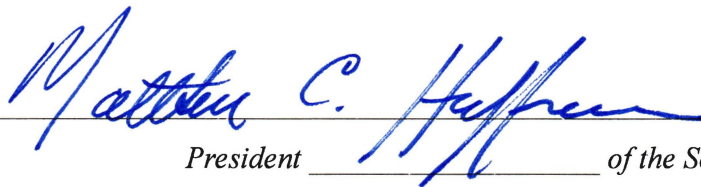
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

Sec. 5.2316. The nineteenth day of November is designated as "James A. Garfield Day."



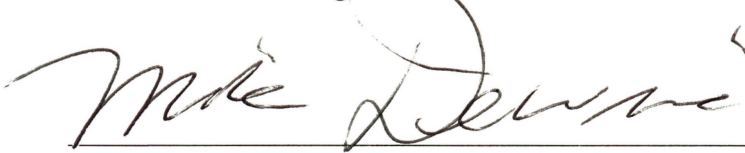
